

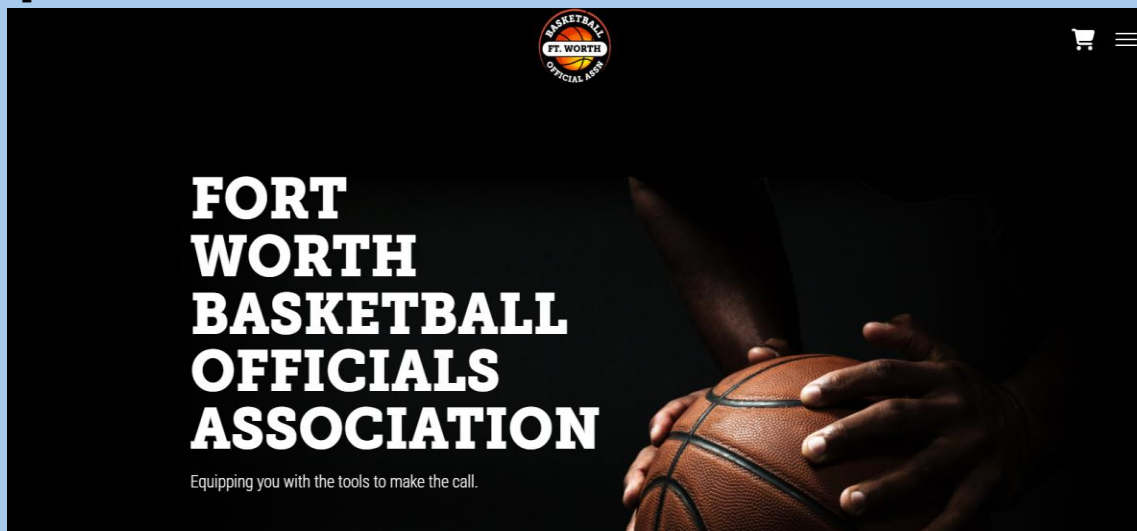
FWBOA New Official Guide

2. Open the menu

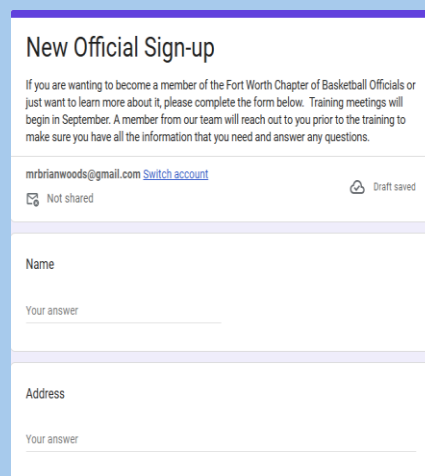
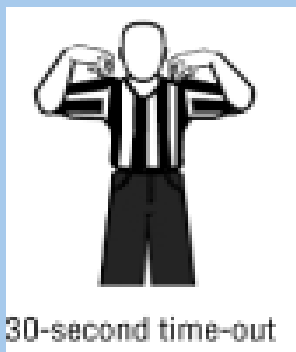


3. Scroll down on the home page and click the NEW OFFICIALS banner



STEP 1 - Complete the New Officials Application

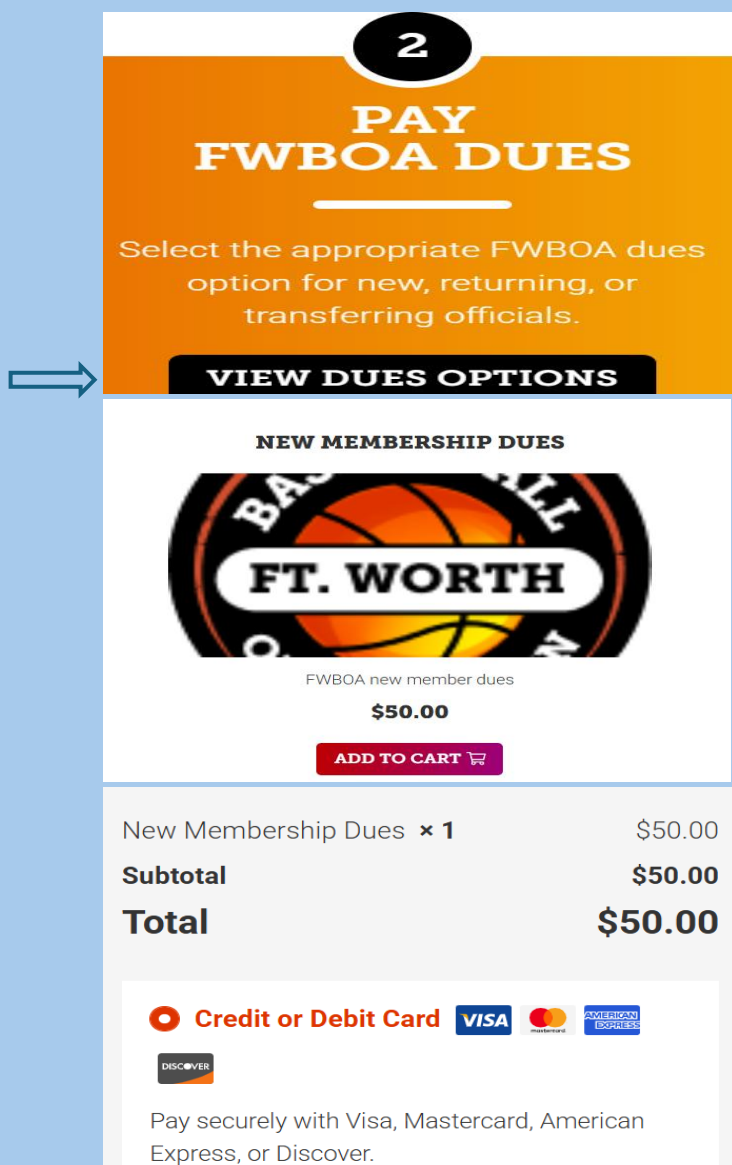
Click **New Officials Application** and submit the **FWBOA New Official Sign-Up Form**.

STEP 3 - Register with THSBOA (State)

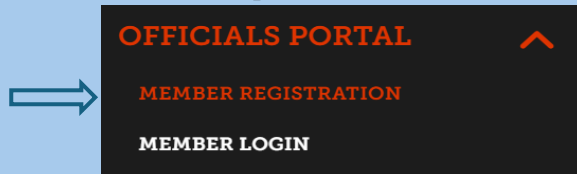
Complete your **THSBOA registration** to meet state requirements for officiating UIL basketball.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

After completing Steps 1-3, new officials will receive information about:

- New Officials Training - Required instruction in rules, mechanics, positioning, and game management.
- FWBOA Officials Camp - Camp participation, learning opportunities, and on-court feedback.
- Required Tests - Rules, mechanics, and eligibility tests that must be completed by published deadlines.
- Chapter Meetings - Required meetings and chapter communications throughout the season.
- Important Dates - Training, camp, testing, meeting, and registration deadlines.
- Arbiter / Game Assignments - Account setup, availability, assignments, and schedule changes.
- Uniform & Equipment - Required uniform, shoes, whistle, lanyard, timing tools, and other equipment.
